



day two: reverence

Isaiah 6:2-4

*"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty;
the whole earth is full of His glory."*

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OPENING PRAYER (Colossians 1:9–14; Isaiah 11:1–2)

Father,
we ask that you fill us with the knowledge of your will
in all wisdom and spiritual understanding,

**so that we may walk in a manner
worthy and pleasing to you:
bearing fruit in every good work and growing in the
knowledge of God,
being strengthened with all power, according to your
glorious might,
so that we may have great endurance and patience,
joyfully giving thanks to you, our Father, for enabling
us to share in the saints' inheritance in the light.**

You have rescued us from the domain of darkness and
transferred us into the kingdom of the Son you love, our
Lord, Jesus Christ.

**In whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.
Amen.**

SCRIPTURE READING: Isaiah 6:1

In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and
exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe
filled the temple.

*You are holy, holy
Lord God Almighty
Lord, You are Worthy
You are holy, holy
The whole earth is full of,
Full of Your glory*

*You are high above
Reigning Strong
Seated in glory
The throne is yours alone
Your presence fills this place
Your mercy overflows
Help us see you now
Greater than we've ever known*

*You are holy, holy
Lord God Almighty
Lord, You are Worthy
You are holy, holy
The whole earth is full of,
Full of Your glory*

After having a revelation of God. Seeing Him as He truly is, we are now shown the eternal response of the heavenly realm, and we join in reverence and awe as we enter further into Isaiah's vision and another throne room vision given to John, which is the only other place in Scripture we see the refrain:

Holy, Holy, Holy.

As we read through these Scriptures we will pause and reflect on three key comparisons.

SCRIPTURE READING: Isaiah 6:2-7

Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. And they were calling to one another:

**"Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty;
the whole earth is full of his glory."**

At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke.

*You are holy, holy
Lord God Almighty
Lord, You are Worthy
You are holy, holy
The whole earth is full of,
Full of Your glory*

SCRIPTURE READING: Revelation 4:2-4

Immediately I was in the Spirit, and there was a throne in heaven and someone was seated on it. The one seated there had the appearance of jasper and carnelian stone. A rainbow that had the appearance of an emerald surrounded the throne.

Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones sat twenty-four elders dressed in white clothes, with golden crowns on their heads.

*You are holy, holy
Lord God Almighty
Lord, You are Worthy
You are holy, holy
The whole earth is full of,
Full of Your glory*

*Holy, holy, holy! Lord God Almighty!
Early in the morning our song shall rise to thee.
Holy, holy, holy! Merciful and mighty!
God in three Persons, blessed Trinity!*

THRONES

Isaiah's vision from the past sees one throne; John's vision of the future sees 24 more thrones. This represents the complete church present in the throne room of God. 12 thrones representing the people of God before Jesus came, and 12 representing the people of God after Jesus came. In this future vision of John, God has invited his people to join Him in His rule and reign over the earth.

Consider what it means to be a part of God's rule and reign.

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*Holy, holy, holy! All the saints adore thee,
Casting down their golden crowns
around the glassy sea.
Cherubim and seraphim, falling down before thee,
Who was and is and evermore shall be.*

SCRIPTURE READING: Revelation 4:5–6a

Flashes of lightning and rumblings and peals of thunder came from the throne. Seven fiery torches were burning before the throne, which are the seven spirits of God. Something like a sea of glass, similar to crystal, was also before the throne.

7 SPIRITS OF GOD

Isaiah's vision had no vision of the 7 fiery torches or lamps which are the 7 spirits of God that John's vision has.

But we are the church.

We are the people of God after Jesus and because of Jesus' birth, life, death, resurrection and ascension, the Spirit has been poured out on us. Scholars says these torches represent the 7 gifts of the spirit that God gave to the church, and they are foreshadowed by the coming of the Messiah as mentioned in Isaiah 11:1-2:

**Then a shoot will grow from the stump of Jesse,
and a branch from his roots will bear fruit.**

**The Spirit (1) of the LORD will rest on him—
a Spirit (2) of wisdom and (3) understanding,
a Spirit (4) of counsel and (5) strength,
a Spirit (6) of knowledge and
(7) of the fear of the LORD.**

7 represents the number of completion and perfection. The fullness of His Spirit has been given to us, and His Spirit comes from the very throne room itself. And as we see in John's vision, the fullness of the Spirit is present through all eternity!

What in your life is holding you back from experiencing the fullness of His Spirit flowing through you today?

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*Holy, holy, holy! Though the darkness hide thee,
Though the eye of sinful man thy glory may not see,
Only thou art holy; there is none beside thee,
Perfect in pow'r, in love, and purity.*

SCRIPTURE READING: Revelation 4:6b–11

Four living creatures covered with eyes in front and in back were around the throne on each side. The first living creature was like a lion; the second living creature was like an ox; the third living creature had a face like a man; and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle. Each of the four living creatures had six wings; they were covered with eyes around and inside. Day and night they never stop, saying,

**Holy, holy, holy,
Lord God, the Almighty,
who was, who is, and who is to come.**

Whenever the living creatures give glory, honor, and thanks to the one seated on the throne, the one who lives forever and ever, the twenty-four elders fall down before the one seated on the throne and worship the one who lives forever and ever. They cast their crowns before the throne and say,

**Our Lord and God,
you are worthy to receive
glory and honor and power,
because you have created all things,
and by your will
they exist and were created.**

SIX-WINGED SERAPHIM

The six-winged seraphim go through significant changes from Isaiah's vision to John's vision. In Isaiah's vision the seraphim have their faces and feet covered, but in John's vision their wings are open wide, and the seraphim are described in detail. Their wings have changed as well—they are now covered in eyes! Why such a drastic change? Because there is now a slaughtered lamb sitting in the midst of the throne! This lamb is the image of the invisible God; the one on whom all eyes are now fixed for He is worthy to open the scrolls.

SCRIPTURE READING: Revelation 5:6–14

Then I saw one like a slaughtered lamb standing in the midst of the throne and the four living creatures and among the elders. He had seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent into all the earth. He went and took the scroll out of the right hand of the one seated on the throne.

When he took the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb. Each one had a harp and golden bowls filled with incense, which are the prayers of the saints. And they sang a new song:

**You are worthy to take the scroll
and to open its seals,
because you were slaughtered,
and you purchased people
for God by your blood
from every tribe and language
and people and nation.
You made them a kingdom
and priests to our God,**

and they will reign on the earth.

Then I looked and heard the voice of many angels around the throne, and also of the living creatures and of the elders. Their number was countless thousands, plus thousands of thousands. They said with a loud voice,

**Worthy is the Lamb who was slaughtered
to receive power and riches
and wisdom and strength
and honor and glory and blessing!**

I heard every creature in heaven, on earth, under the earth, on the sea, and everything in them say,

**Blessing and honor and glory and power
be to the one seated on the throne,
and to the Lamb, forever and ever!**

The four living creatures said, "Amen," and the elders fell down and worshiped.

*Holy, holy, holy! Lord God Almighty!
All thy works shall praise thy name, in earth,
and sky, and sea;
Holy, holy, holy! Merciful and mighty!
God in three Persons, blessed Trinity.*

*You are holy, holy

Full of Your glory*

CLOSING PRAYER (Colossians 1: 15–20):

Jesus, Lamb of God,

**You are the image of the invisible God,
the firstborn over all creation.
Everything was created by you,
in heaven and on earth,
the visible and the invisible,
whether thrones or dominions
or rulers or authorities—
all things have been created through you and for you.
You are before all things,
and by you all things hold together.
You are the head of the body, the church;
you are the beginning,
the firstborn from the dead,
and you have first place in everything.**

**God was pleased to have
all his fullness, the Spirit, dwell in you,
and through you, the Son, to reconcile
everything to himself, the Father,
whether things on earth or things in heaven,
by making peace through your blood,
shed on the cross.
Amen.**
